Introduction

Firstly, our school is located in Hatvan. At present it has more than 450 students and they study different sectors including Economics, Informatics, Management, High School and Health. The IT students are supported by the school's Cisco online curriculum access which is not available for all schools in Hungary. As for the English language, students learn in small groups of 15-20 people. Moreover, they can get a Pannon language exam, too. Besides it, studying German is also available.

As for the school itself it was renovated in the summer of 2014. It has been painted green and the windows have been replaced so it is very nice now. In 2018, the students of Health sector received a new building. As a result, they can get easier to make the necessary knowledge because it is a very well-equipped building.

Community and sports activities

Our school is a church-maintained school since 2012. Consequently, once a month, the whole school goes to a nearby church and prays together. In the Advent period, we lit the candles together on the Advent wreaths and wait quietly for Christmas. In this time, we always think of the needy and collect donations to make their Christmas more beautiful.
