- 1. The teacher using 24 papers divides the students into four groups of six students.
- 2. Sentence "Water Connects the Whole World" print four times and cut into 24 pieces. Each student takes one paper and all the students with the word water form one group, with the word joins the other group, etc.
- 3. Each of the groups gets the job.
- 4. Printed Blind Map with four cities.
- 5. The pupils have to connect these cities through the waterways, therefore only through rivers, lakes, seas can travel to reach the desired destination.
- 6. Each group must have:
 - a. two cell phone and / or computer
 - b. blue pencil
- 7. Divide Units Group Tasks (LEAVE TASKS ON EVERY TABLE):
 - a. TWO PUPILS USE OF MOBILE AND COMPUTER WITH GOOGLE MAPS

 APPLICATION WILL FIND A ROUTE THROUGH THE CONSTRUCTIONS ON THE

 MAP
 - b. TWO STUDENTS SHOULD TURN TO THE BLIND MAP AND IMPORT WATER FACILITIES WITH NAMES
 - c. TWO PUPILS OF ARE FINDING INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT RIVERS THAT ARE INCLUDED IN MAP AND COUNTS THE DISTANCE OF THE WAY, AND PREPARE FOR PRESENTATION OF DATA RECEIVED
- 8. The teacher visits all groups and is actively monitoring the progress, difficulties and work of each group.
- 9. After each activity is completed, each group photographs their work and sends them to the computer to open and clarify their routes to everyone.
- 1. Upon completion of the activity, the students should agree a sentence from the words obtained in each group.
